



The Island Insulation Scheme offers private households free or subsidised cavity wall and loft insulation. Insulating your home properly could save hundreds of pounds on your fuel bills and make your home warmer and more comfortable. It is also good for the environment.

Prices for cavity wall insulation range from £150-180 and loft insulation from £185-202. However, if anyone living in your home is aged 70 or over or in receipt of a qualifying benefit then the insulation will be installed FREE OF CHARGE. This is an excellent opportunity to have your home properly insulated.

The Scheme is backed by the Isle of Wight Council and is delivered by E.ON through local installers Mark Group which has a base on the Island. Mark Group has recently been approved and registered onto the Councils Trading Standards 'Buy with Confidence' which ensures that they are operating legally and with a strong focus on customer care.



The Scheme is using a Heatseeker vehicle to identify those properties which would benefit from insulation. The vehicle takes a thermal image of the property but can only see the exterior of the building and cannot see through walls or windows. Once this has been completed, a letter will be delivered through your door and shortly after an advisor will call at your home to discuss your options to reduce heat loss. Of course, the scheme is entirely optional and if you wish not to participate you can simply inform the Advisor or call HeatSeekers Opt Out in advance in advance on 0800 111 4968.
